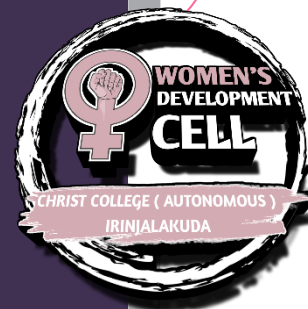

It was led by Aparna Lavakumar, Senior Civil Police officer, Women's Police Station, Irinjalakuda, and P.R. Bijoy, CI of Police, Kodungalooore. Aparna Lavakumar in 2008 donated her three golden bangles to release a dead body from a private hospital in Thrissur. She made discussion about the safety of women and explained how to improve the confidence of women students through different methods. She stressed the necessity of women to have proficiency in martial arts.

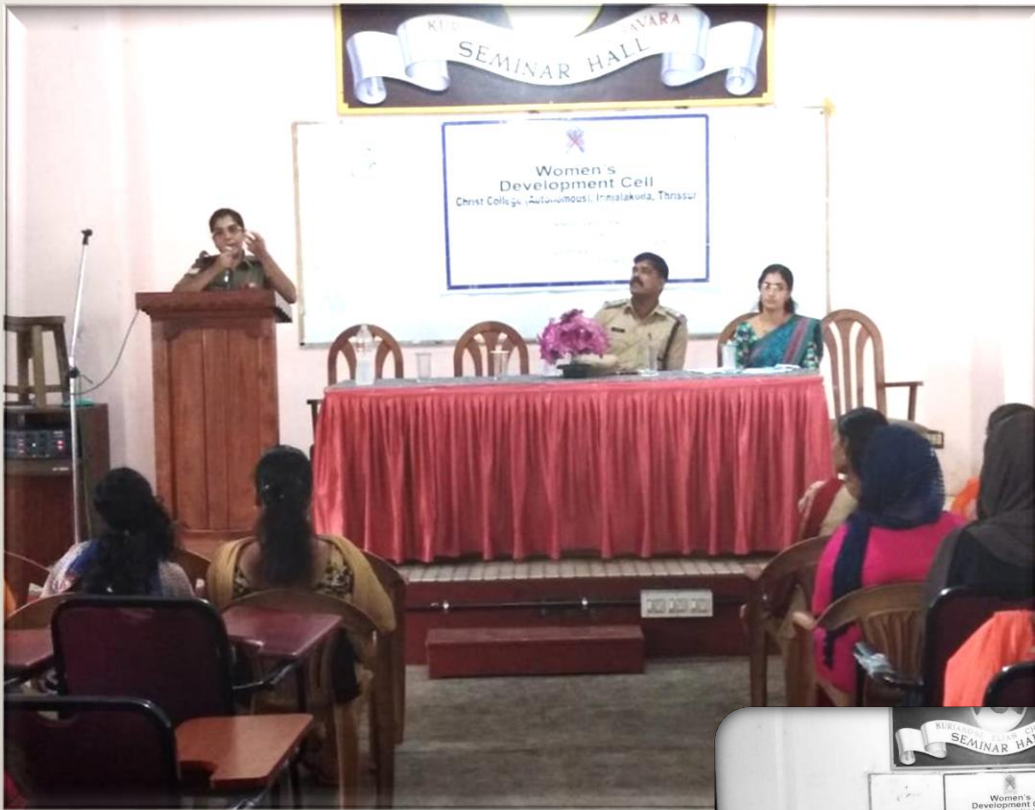

In the afternoon interactive session started on the topic Gender and Health, in order to develop the skills to interact with all genders comfortably and respectfully and gain scientifically accurate knowledge about the human reproductive system, and the emotional and sexual changes that one undergoes. Dr.J.S.Veena, Junior, Resident in Forensic, Government Medical College, Trivandrum, had lead the session. This was an interesting interactive session in which she discussed human reproductive systems, hormonal changes etc. in an elaborate manner and the students irrespective of their gender asked their doubts regarding human body, sexual changes etc.
