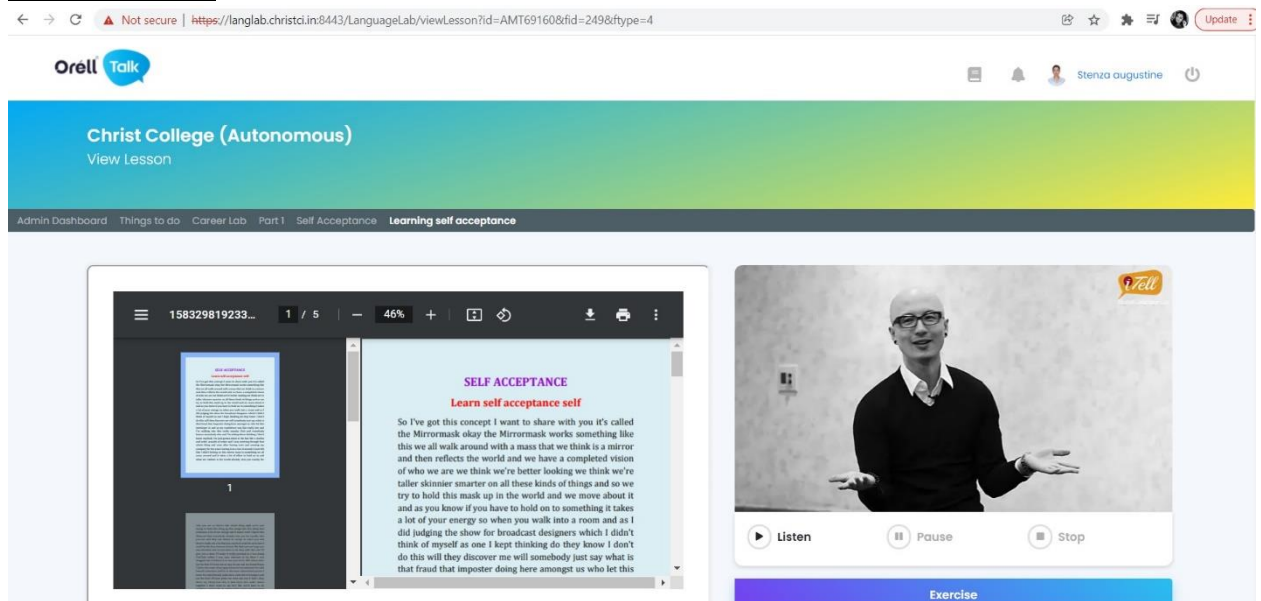

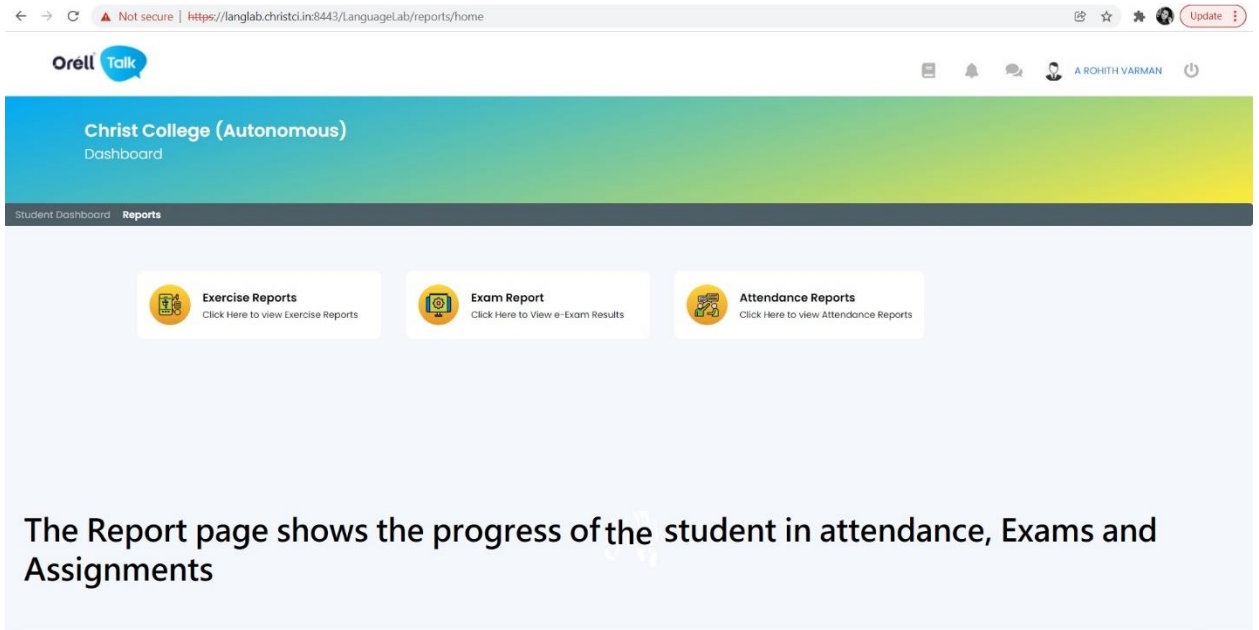
E-Exam option helps the teacher to assign a class test for students of a particular class by setting a question paper and uploading it.
