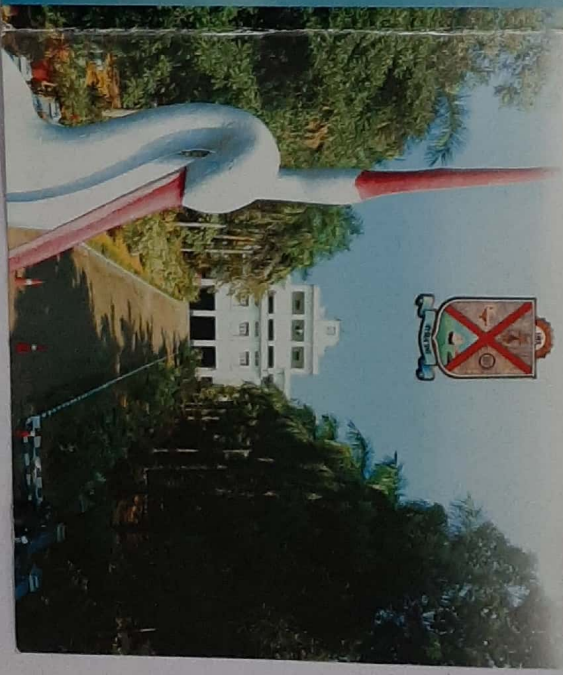

Christ College was started in 1956, by the Devamatha Province of the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI), A Minority Institution, affiliated to Calicut University and Re-accredited by NAAC with highest grade 'A', Christ College has been conferred the "Autonomous status" by University Grants Commission (UGC) during the year 2015. At present it has 22 departments of study, 21 UG programmes, 15 PG programmes managed by 160 teachers and 60 members of the non-teaching staff. About 3000 students are currently enrolled in the college both in the aided and unaided streams.
