ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Christ College has its motto "JeevithaPrabha", which means the "Light of Life". Our vision is to mould an enlightened generation through quality higher education. The College offers a total of twenty undergraduate courses; sixteen post graduate courses and six PhD programmes. College has now 192 teaching staff and 38 Non-teaching staff who work ardently towards the future of 3451 students. In addition, we have 52 research students working for their doctoral thesis in six research-departments. In accordance with the National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF), we recently instituted a department for vocational education.

DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY

The Department of Zoology was established in 1957 with B.Sc. programme and was subsequently elevated to postgraduate status in 1961. University of Calicut recognized it as a research department in 1973. All the faculty members of the department are PhD holders and six out of seven are recognized research guides of the parent university. Department has produced 18 PhDs so far and another 19 scholars are pursuing research in various fields of biological studies. Further the department could attract an amount of Rs. 2.25crore from diverse funding agencies like UGC, DST-SERB, MOEF, KSCSTE, CDS and the like under various research schemes.

DEPARTMENT OF VOCATIONAL STUDIES

The department of vocational studies was instituted in the college after UGC has approved a couple of Bachelor degree programme for vocational studies under NSQF, in the year 2018. The department runs two programme, 1. B.Voc (Food Processing Technology) and 2. B. Voc (Information Technology) and are affiliated to University of Calicut. The curriculum is a suitable mix of general education and skill development components and at least 50% of skill component is allotted to practical and industry training and is assigned with National Occupational Standards and Qualification Packs given by the respective Sector Skill Council.

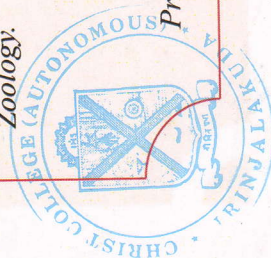
