As it was only a few days ago the honourable Chief Justice of Supreme Court of India insulted a rape victim with his patriarchal values, this topic held special significance in her talk. She described the situations where women were denied justice on the basis of their gender. She described the paradoxical situation that India ensured maximum laws to protect women and how day by day crimes against women were increased. Adv.
