<i>General evaluation of academic progress</i>	<p>The Principal in Charge informed the members about the initiatives taken and the progress made by the College after the last meeting. The initiatives taken to promote academics, sports and infrastructure were also briefed.</p> <p>New Courses: Principal informed the members that following new courses were started in the current academic year. B A Economics, B Com Taxation, M. Sc Chemistry and M. Sc Physics all in the self-financing stream.</p> <p>External examinations and publication of results: The examinations</p>

	<p>which were postponed due to Covid restrictions were completed in the month of November. Principal informed the consolidated results of fourth semester PG (2018 admissions-92%) and sixth semester UG (2017 admissions -76%). Steps taken towards the improvement of results based on the result analysis were also discussed.</p> <p>Academic achievements: College signed Memorandum of Understanding with Integrated Rural Technology Centre, Palakkad in the area of solid waste management. Principal in Charge also announced about the successful completion of National Faculty Development Programme Quality Science Education in India in the 21st century. organized jointly with GAD TLC under the scheme of PMMMNTT, MHRD.</p> <p>Sports achievements: The academic and sports achievements of the current academic year were also reviewed in the meeting. College achieved the title Best College in University of Calicut for sports and games.</p> <p>Infrastructure development: The Principal informed the members about the progress of construction of New Science block. The ladies hostel building works has been started under the RUSA grant.</p> <p>Awards and Achievements: NSS volunteer Sri. Vishnu N S received the best NSS volunteer award of University of Calicut.</p>
New courses for the Academic year 2020-21	<p>College received sanction from Higher Education Council, Government of Kerala to start five year Integrated M.Sc Geology programme. After approving the syllabus forwarded by the Board of studies, Geology. Academic council proposed to Governing Council of the College to start the sanctioned programme in this academic year 2020-21.</p>
Progress on NAAC visit 2021	<p>IQAC Coordinator discussed the progress on upcoming reaccreditation activities. It was decided to complete the first draft of Self Study Report by the end of the December as proposed by the University nominee, Dr. Santhosh Nampy.</p>
Any other relevant matter	<p>Academic council proposed to start new programme Master of Library and Information Science (M.Lib.I.Sc) under the department of Library science. The programme will be of four semesters to be started from the next academic year 2021-2022.</p> <p>It was further decided to change the name of the four year programme</p>

Integrated Bachelor of Physical Education from Integrated B.P.Ed to Integrated B. P. E

Academic council proposed to Governing council to start a Teaching Learning Centre which could be the hub of activities related to Faculty Development Programs for both Christ college teachers as well as for the outside academic community.

Member of the Academic council Dr. K V Radhakrishnan proposed to arrange a pool of resource persons (both from academics and industry) in each department consisting of alumni. These resource persons can give orientation to students about the new trends in each discipline. The Academic Council unanimously decided to develop the resource pool as soon as possible.

It was also proposed to start Interdisciplinary Research Activities with socially relevant projects. Sri Sachin Menon commented that such activities may invite the interest of Corporate world to invest in such research programs.

The meeting ended at 3.45 p.m. with a vote of thanks to the external members by Rev. Fr. Joy P.T, Vice Principal of the college. He thanked all the Members for sparing their valuable time to attend the meeting.
