METHODOLOGY:







Following are the questions and opinions collected from the teachers on curriculum they are handling.





Course content has the latest developments in the subject.







The syllabus helps students to develop a multi-disciplinary perspective.






The syllabus has course components addressing local, national and global issues.









Important Suggestions from teachers

- More Interaction with Students.
