#### **Teaching-Learning Process**

PG Department of Commerce offer Student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies etc. for enhancing learning experiences among the aspirants.

Student-centric learning has been the practice of the college for a long period and this has been reinforced with new ways of learning such as audit courses, foundation courses, and other Inter Departmental certificate courses with embedded Partial Online Courses. Students are given the privilege of opting courses of their own choice. The following activities have been adopted by the faculty at different levels to enrich the student-centric methods. It includes internship, projects, guided seminars, industrial visits, lectures and role play and simulation etc. In order to achieve the objective the Department of Commerce at Christ College (Autonomous), Irinjalakuda formed different club viz, Investors Club, ED Club, News paper Tracking Club and certain certification courses are also offered to the students to enable them experience the real application of what they have learned in class rooms. With this objective in mind, Christ College made a collaboration with Finmark Trainers India Pvt Ltd (Finmark), training students conduct offline /online certification exams for the Finance Market Professional Program (FMP) since 2017 and Diploma in Practical Accounting and Tax Practice since 2016. In the year 2020, college made collaboration with ACCORD EazyLink to impart practical training to the aspirants in Accounting and Banking. Students also get benefited through internship programmes.
