Dr. Anto Alappet, Chairman, BOS in Geology at Christ College Autonomous, welcomed the gathering. The members had actively participated in the discussion and the following suggestions were given.

1. The members reviewed the course outcome for each course and given suggestions of improvement.
2. It was suggested to implement the outcome assessment for the BSc Program in Geology. The members further suggested to improve the course outcome of the MSc. Integrated program.
3. The Board look in to the details of courses in the MSc. Integrated Geology program from the IVth Semester onwards. It was suggested to give a group project, with not exceeding four members in a group. However, if any student wish to undertake individual project He/she may be allowed to do that.
4. BSc. Geology group project may also be completed as groups not more than 8 students. Students may be encouraged to visit research institutions or universities as part of their project to carry out analyses for the project.
5. MSc Applied Geology students ~~are~~ should be encouraged to take up external funding for their Internship / Dissertation (Eg: KSCSTE Student project)
6. Field studies for MSc. Integrated students at Vth / VIth Semester and during VIII / IXth Semester were suggested to be included as mandatory in the Syllabus.
7. Students were encouraged to take up internships during the IVth Year for the MSc. Integrated Geology prog.
8. MSc. Applied Geology students to be encouraged to present their dissertations findings in National / International conferences and more should be held to hold the students.
