Minutes

- The meeting started with a silent prayer.
- Secretary Dr. N. Anil Kumar welcomed the executive members. He also thanked one and all for the active participation during the Autonomy revisit dated 16th and 17th July 2022.
- Principal, Fr. Dr. Jolly Andrews reminded the meeting about the upcoming SAAC visit scheduled on 22nd and 23rd September 2022, which is one of the major milestones.
- Principal pointed out the major features influencing the college such as;
 - ✓ Geographical peculiarity of the college, being situated in a B grade rural village.
 - ✓ Most students are from rural village background.
- Principal also discussed the dream project of the college, ie - to be an Aided Deemed-to-be University, sought whole hearted support of the executive committee and the members of the association. He also substantiated this with valid reason, that majority students who are from village/rural background who are not financially strong, will be the ones who will be the direct beneficiaries of having courses in aided stream.
- Principal also discussed about the implementation of NEP. He informed the meeting that we already had Pandit Madhan Mohan Malaviya National Seminar for teachers.
- Need of synthetic track was another point discussed during the meeting.
- Vice-Principal, Fr. Joy P. T. made the following remarks during the meeting;
 - ✓ As part of providing up-to-date resources to the students we have upgraded our facilities.
 - ✓ We need to source more fund from individuals, collect CSR funds from companies.
 - ✓ Need to collect more endowments.

- Fr. Joy P. T also reminded the meeting about providing only positive suggestions during the Alumni interaction of the upcoming SAAC & NAAC visit.
- IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Robinson gave instructions to the executive members regarding how to deal with the SAAC & NAAC audit team with some possible questions.
- Secretary, Dr. N. Anilkumar updated the meeting with the following statistics and schedules;
 - ✓ Our registered Alumni members strength is now more than 4000.
 - ✓ General Body Alumni Meeting will be held on 2nd Saturday of March, every year.
 - ✓ Union members Alumni Meeting will be held on
 - ✓ Department Alumni will be held on 2nd Saturday of March, every year.
- Principal presented the following figures of alumni contribution year-on-year;
 - ✓ 2019 - '20 Rs. 16,05,500/-
 - ✓ 2020 - '21 Rs. 13,24,644/-
 - ✓ 2021 - '22 Rs. 22,55,000/-

These amounts were spent on scholarships, renovation of labs and other related infrastructure facilities of the college.
