Fr. Sibi Francis, Men's Hostel Warden, informed the committee that the enquiry report of the ragging complaint received from the hostellers on 9th March 2022 had been submitted to the Principal after the enquiry on 21-03-2022.

Dr. Aravinda B.P. informed the members regarding the anonymous complaint to the UGC anti-ragging cell and the query received. The Committee had gone to all third year classes and given orientation about ragging and its consequences. No complaint had been received by the institution. All steps taken to look into the matter was informed to the UGC.

The committee decided to organise an orientation programme for the second and

third year students and hostellers before the admission of first year students was completed.

Second and third year students and their parents should be asked to submit the online anti-ragging affidavit.

Ms. Mary Pathrose informed that anti-ragging boards were in the process of being put up in various parts of the campus after the renovation work.

The committee decided that the anti-ragging squad would pay sudden periodical visits to the men's and ladies' hostels.

Hostel wardens informed that cameras had been installed in all common areas of both hostels.

It was also decided to create an anti-ragging cell mail id so that students could register their complaints.

The meeting came to a close at 3.15 pm with a vote of thanks by the convener.
