ABSTRACT

Parental stress has been found to have a significant impact on caregivers psychological health and to increase the likelihood that caregivers may unwillingly leave disabled children in the care of others. Policy making must be guided by an understanding of effective ways to reduce the responsibilities of caregiving, which will enable better and more individualised assistance and intervention for the kids. Using parental stress as a mediating factor, this study intends to describe caregivers of children with intellectual impairments who are about to seek outside support and care as well as to determine the circumstances under which psychological well-being and parental stress are altered. We discovered that psychological well-being was significantly impacted by parental stress and the child's depressed symptoms. Also, We discovered that the child's melancholy feelings and parental stress had a significant impact on psychological well-being. Researchers also discovered a connection between limited career social interactions and parental stress to safeguard psychological wellbeing.

ABSTRACT

Homosexuality is a romantic attraction, sexual attraction, or sexual behavior between members of the same sex or gender. As a sexual orientation, homosexuality is “an enduring pattern of emotional, romantic, and/or sexual attractions” to people of same sex. 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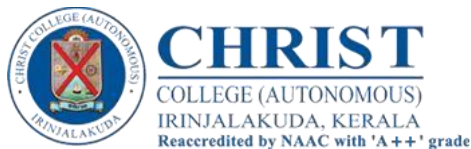

Menopause is a natural process that results in atresia of almost all oocytes in ovaries, causing an increase in follicle-stimulating hormone and luteinizing hormone levels and a decrease in estrogen levels. Menopausal symptoms impact physical, psychological, vasomotor, and sexual health-related quality of life among women. The study was planned with the aim to assess the commonly reported menopausal symptoms among rural women of Sreenarayanapuram Grampanchayath using the menopause rating scale. Menopause-related symptoms are highly prevalent among middle-aged women in rural areas of Sreenarayanapuram panchayath this signifies the urgent need for community-based screening for such condition. Physical symptoms (joint and muscle problems) are the most commonly reported one. Healthcare providers have to be sensitized to special health needs of these rural middle-aged menopausal women. Menopause is a natural process that results in atresia of almost all oocytes in ovaries, causing an increase in follicle-stimulating hormone and luteinizing hormone levels and a decrease in estrogen levels. Menopausal symptoms impact physical, psychological, vasomotor, and sexual health-related quality of life among women. The study was planned with the aim to assess the commonly reported menopausal symptoms among rural women of Sreenarayanapuram Grampanchayath using the menopause rating scale. Menopause-related symptoms are highly prevalent among middle-aged women in rural areas of Sreenarayanapuram panchayath this signifies the urgent need for community-based screening for such condition. 

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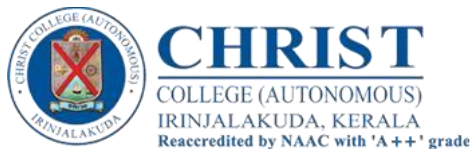

As a sexual orientation, homosexuality is “an enduring pattern of emotional, romantic, and/or sexual attractions” to people of same sex. It “also refers to a person’s sense of identity based on those attractions, related behaviors, and membership in a community of others who share those attractions.

This study aims to identify the psycho-social perspective of youth towards homosexuals. For this data was collected from 50 respondents on a self structured questionnaire. The data was analyzed using SPSS .

Among the interviewees, more than half believe that homosexual in the society shouldn’t be excluded. The majority of responses were pro-homosexual. The majority of respondents think it’s acceptable for two people of the same sex to clasp hands or show affection in public. The majority of respondents said they would support a homosexual candidate for public office. The majority of respondents don’t find it uncomfortable if there are homosexuals nearby.

The majority of respondents exhibit a favorable outlook toward gay couples. More than half of the respondents think that homosexuals still uphold society’s moral standards
