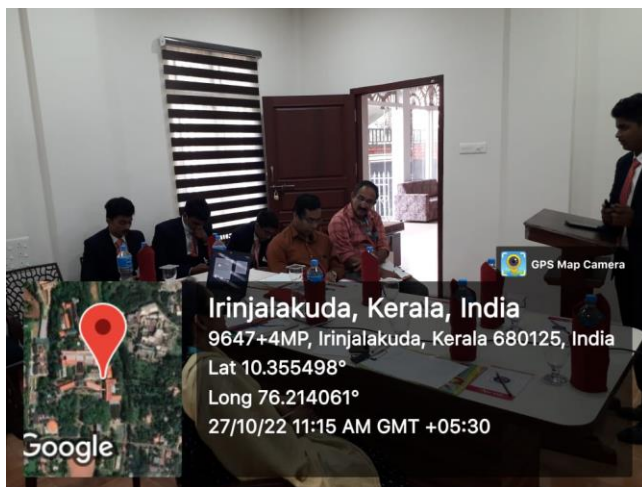
## GROUP DISCUSSION

A seminar session was conducted on various topics other than the subjects. Selected members from the teams were asked to explain a given topic and after explaining they asked questions to the members of group.



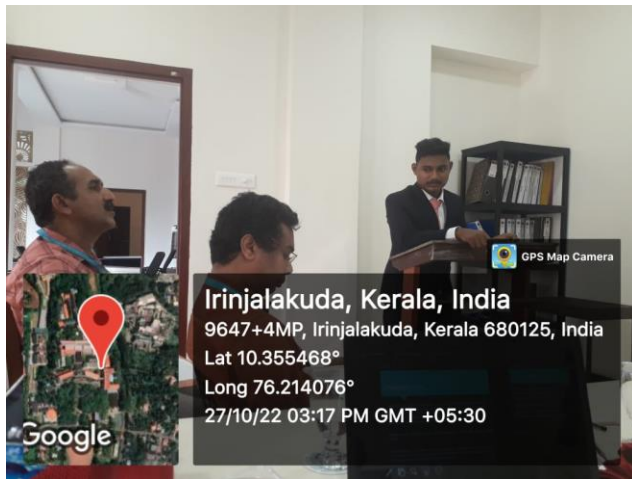
## PRACTICAL (FOOD AND BEVERAGE PRODUCTION & BAR OPERATIONS)

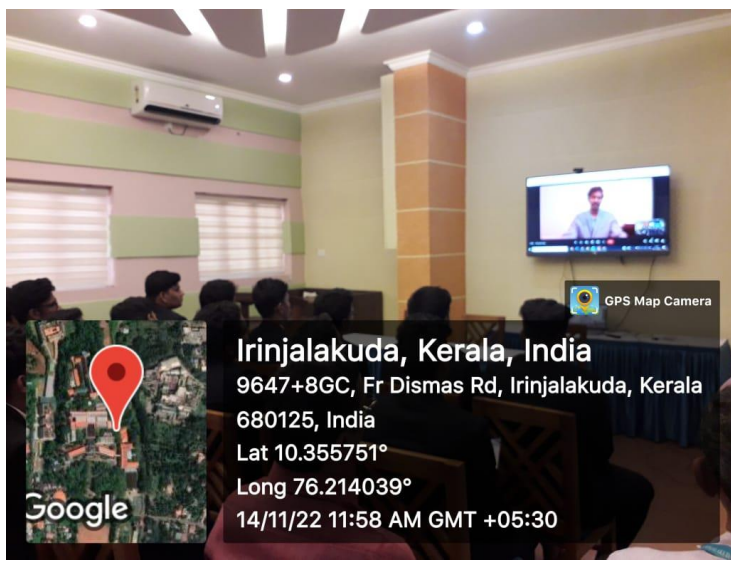
## MOCK INTERVIEW

A seminar session was conducted. Selected members from the teams were asked to explain a given topic and after explaining they asked questions to the members of group.

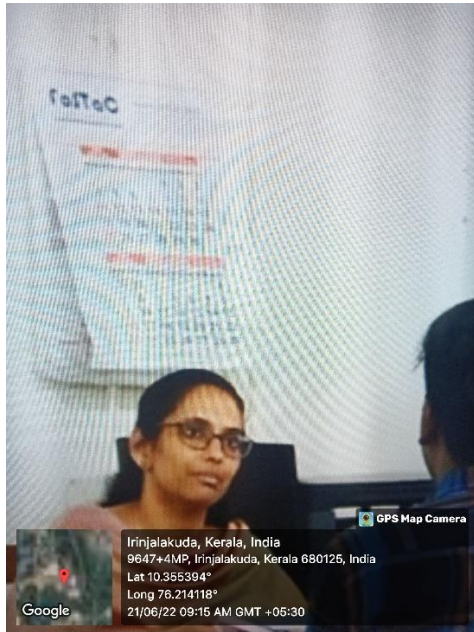
### **PRACTICAL** (Food and Beverage Production & Bar operations)

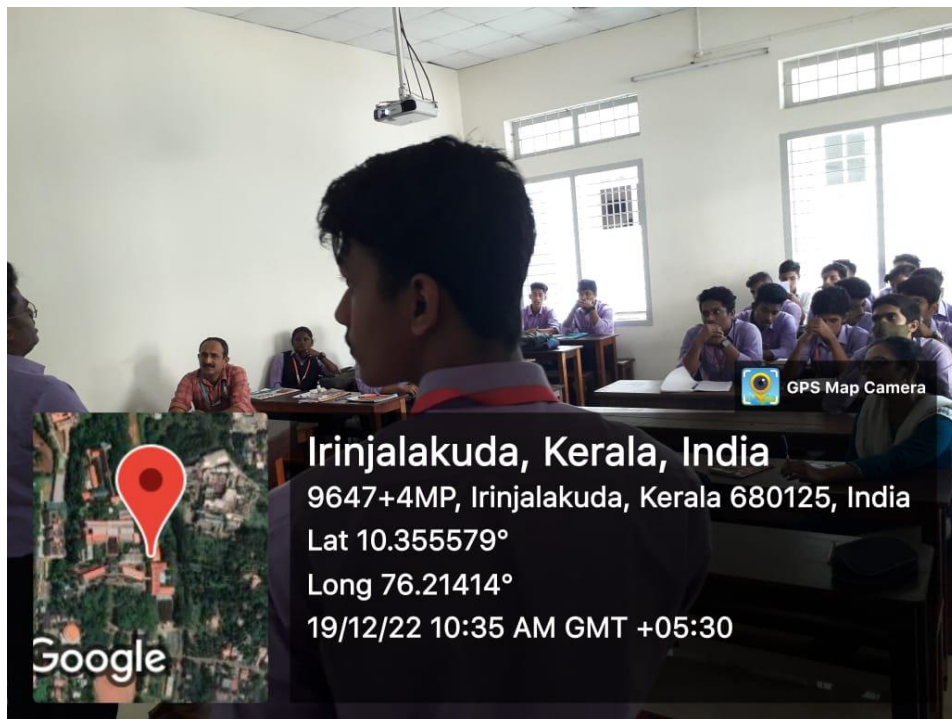

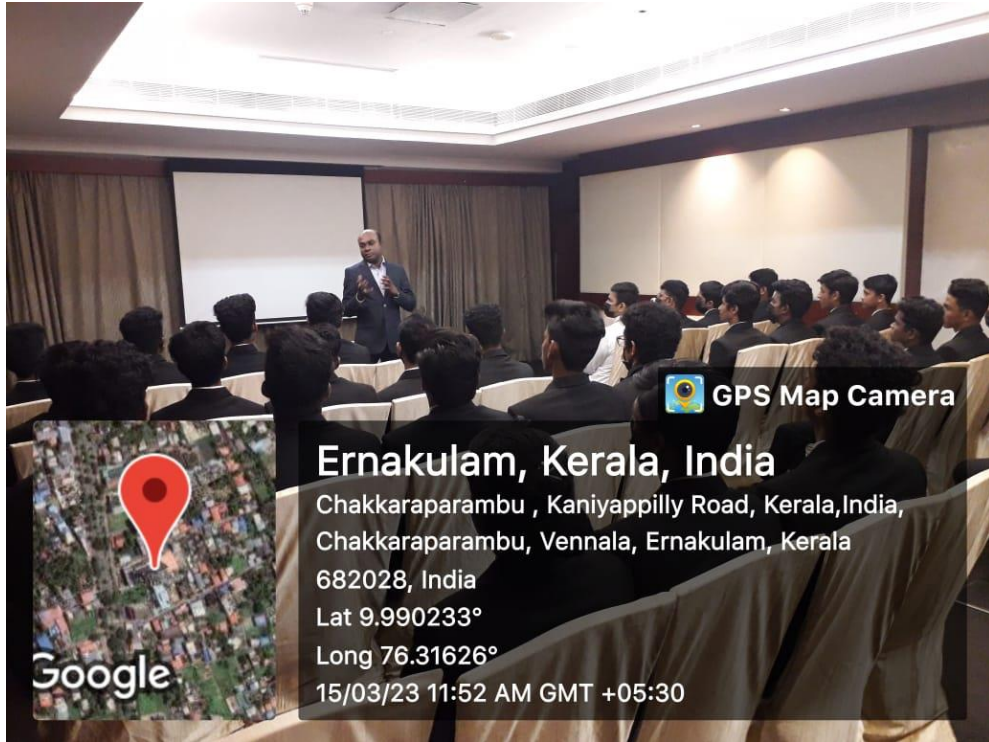
## **PRACTICAL (FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE & HOUSEKEEPING)**


