INTRODUCTION

Christ College (Autonomous) in Irinjalakuda has shown an unwavering commitment to actively tackle educational inequalities among students. Using a comprehensive range of affirmative actions, the college aims to bridge the gap between students who learn at different paces which allows students to unlock their potential and progress at a pace that suits their learning abilities. Each department adopts a personalized strategy, implementing various measures to ensure continuous growth throughout the students' academic journey.

A notable example of the college's dedication to inclusive education is the implementation of Peer Learning Groups (PLGs). This collaborative initiative marks a positive step toward addressing different learning speeds among students. Assessment of student learning levels includes two methods: direct, which comprises a screening test covering English, core subjects, and a psychometric test; and indirect, such as the Student Induction Programme, which provides insights into academic levels and family backgrounds through interactive sessions. Remedial actions for slow learners involve additional mentoring, assignments, counselling, and group learning activities. Advance learners receive support through advanced tasks, online courses, event participation, and industrial experiences.



To establish PLGs, the class is strategically divided into smaller groups, ensuring a fair distribution of slow and fast learners in each group. Each group is assigned a mentor and a leader who oversees various activities tailored to address specific learning needs. This approach promotes personalized learning, actively encouraging students to adapt activities according to their requirements.
