







Evaluation of NAAC reaccreditation	<p>The Principal in Charge congratulate IQAC for the successful completion of SAAC and NAAC accreditation. A detailed discussion on NAAC accreditation report was carried out by Dr. Robinson P. Ponmuniessery. He pointed out that the college got the highest scores in Curricular aspects, College infrastructure and Best practices. The low scored areas of Research and innovations should be addressed in next cycle.</p> <p>Another metric in which special attention required is Teaching learning. Measures are to be taken to increase the teacher quality (Ph.D, DSc.)</p> <p>Academic Council proposed the following suggestions from these report analysis</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All teachers those who do not have Ph. D should register for it as early as possible</li> <li>2. Interdisciplinary research should be strengthened. College has to identify the departments that can collaborate with interdisciplinary research</li> </ol>

3. Collaboration with industry and premium institutions should be enhanced for syllabus modification. This will help to increase the campus placement and higher studies in reputed institutions

4. Each BoS is suggested to collect feedback from industry nominee before the syllabus modification

Evaluation of  
SAAC accreditation

Dr. Robinson P Ponminiesery concluded that the suggestions and feedback of SAAC accreditation is almost same as that of NAAC report. The peer team visit for SAAC accreditation helped the college to prepare for the NAAC reaccreditation.

New Programmes

Academic Council proposed to Governing Council to start the following new programmes for the academic year 2023-24

1. MPES
2. MSW
3. MSc Cyber Security
4. BCA
5. B Com Computer Applications
6. B Com Finance
7. Triple main, Mathematics, Statistics and Computer Science

8. Bachelor of Graphics and Animations
9. Bachelor of Visual Communications
10. Graduate Programmes in Robotics, Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning.

### Syllabus Modifications :-

For the programme BCom Professional, it was decided to adopt the revised syllabus of the University of Calicut for the course in English A01 - Litmosphere: The World of Literature. However it was also decided to follow the pattern - internal 20, external 80, end semester exam duration 3 hours in alignment with other courses of the programme

Any other relevant matter

### 1. Admission Process

Dr. Shajee K.Y proposed to conduct entrance test for admission to various UG, PG programmes. It was decided to modify admission procedure accordingly and submit to Governing Council for approval.

### 2. Modifying BoS

It was also proposed to include faculties from core subjects while modifying Syllabi of Complementary Courses.

### 3. Research

It was proposed to start Christ College Research Journal. Academic council proposed to take necessary steps to include the research journal in UGC CARE list

### 4. Skill Based Courses

It was also decided to enhance number of skill based courses in the curriculum in alignment with NSDF

5. The programme name of B. Voc. Information Technology name need to be changed to B. Voc. Internet of Things and Data Science.

6. Academic council decided to invite researchers from reputed premium institutions pursuing research under Prime Minister Research Fund (PMRF) for engaging in teaching and have an interaction with our students to motivate them for research and higher studies in reputed institutions.

The meeting ended at 4:30 pm with a vote of thanks to the external members by Fr. Joy P.T, Vice Principal of the college. He thanked all the members for sparing their valuable time to attend the meeting.
