

Since next year onwards Geogebra will be in the syllabus of Plus Two Mathematics, this session was very much beneficial to the teachers from nearby plus two schools.




Fig 3- Inaugural Address by Dr. sumesh S S, Assistant Professor, St. John's College, Anchal




Fig 8- Training Programme by Dr. Sumesh S S, Assistant Professor, St. John's college Anchal
