REPORT

National seminar- “Faunal diversity and recent trends in animal taxonomy” conducted on 20 and 21 of December 2017 at Seminar Hall, Christ College, Irinjalakuda.

Programme on 20/12/2017

The seminar was inaugurated by Dr. K.K. Joshi, Head and Principal Scientist, Marine Biodiversity Division, CMFRI, Kochi. The inaugural session was presided over by Fr. Jacob Njerinjampilly C.M.I, Manager, Christ College, Irinjalakuda. Principal-in-charge, Dr. Mathew Paul Ukken gave the message. The gathering was welcomed by Dr. Pius K. Jacob, Head, Dept. of Zoology.

After inaugural session, the first technical session began by 11.00 am with the keynote address by Dr. K.K Joshi, on “Marine Ichthyofaunal diversity of India”. This session was chaired by Associate Professor, Dr. V.F. Paul (Retd.).

After lunch, the second session (2.00-3.00 p.m.) of the day began with the talk by Dr. John Prasanth Jacob, Scientist F, IFGTB Coimbatore, on “Insect pest diversity in plantation forestry”. Programme on 21/12/2017

The fourth technical session (9:30 am to 11:00 am) of the seminar started with the talk by Dr. Aneesh E. M., Director. CDRL, St. Joseph’s college, Irinjalakuda on “Diversity and vectorial capacity of mosquitoes” which was chaired by Dr. C. O. Joshi, Associate Professor, Christ College, Irinjalakuda.

The second session of the paper presentation started at 11:15 am and ended at 1:00 pm which was chaired by Dr. Balu T Kuzhuveli, Retd. Associate Professor, Dept. of Zoology, and Dr. Tessy Paul P, Associate Professor, Dept. of Botany, Christ College, Irinjalakuda.

There were a total of 23 presentations of students, research scholars and young faculty from various colleges of South India. Best presentation award was won by Ranjini Rajan N., Research scholar, Dept. of Zoology, Government College, Kasaragod.

The last technical session of the seminar (1.30-2.30 p.m.) started with the talk by Dr. Ramachandran Kotharambath, Assistant Professor, Central University of Kerala, on "**The new Taxonomy-The paradigm shift and recent turbulence in describing species**". The valedictory function was inaugurated by the chief guest, Dr. Ramachandran Kotharambath, which was presided over by Principal, Dr. Mathew Paul Ukkenn. Summing up of the presentations was done by Dr. Balu T. Kuzhivelil and the **Best presentation award** was declared by Dr. Tessy Paul P. The seminar came to a happy end at 3.30p.m with National anthem.

SUMMARY

- There were a total of 11~~b~~ participants.
- There were five invited talks and 31 original research papers.
- An oral presentation contest was organized and the best presenter was awarded with a certificate of merit and a cash award of Rs. 3000/-
- India, particularly the state of Kerala is rich in faunal diversity; many species are yet to be identified and more research and funding are required in this area.
- Application of molecular tools in taxonomic research is the need of the time. Studies in this direction are to be supported.
- Concerns were raised about doing taxonomy without voucher specimens and emphasized the need for building up a flexible approach for describing species.
- Highlighted the need for exploring botanical derivatives as a powerful weapon in preventing deadly transmission of vector borne diseases.
- Stressed the importance of integrative taxonomy; different novel tools should supplement classical taxonomy instead of replacing it.
- Emphasized the advantage of insect feeding resistance thereby enhancing crop productivity and management of pest and diseases.
- Highlighted the need for implementation of reference point and notification of massive reserves for protection and conservation of marine and coastal biodiversity.
