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previous QPs and were guided through a structured analysis of question types, distribution of marks, and common pitfalls to avoid.

2. To provide strategies for improving sentence clarity and coherence through proper word choice, sentence structure, and punctuation.



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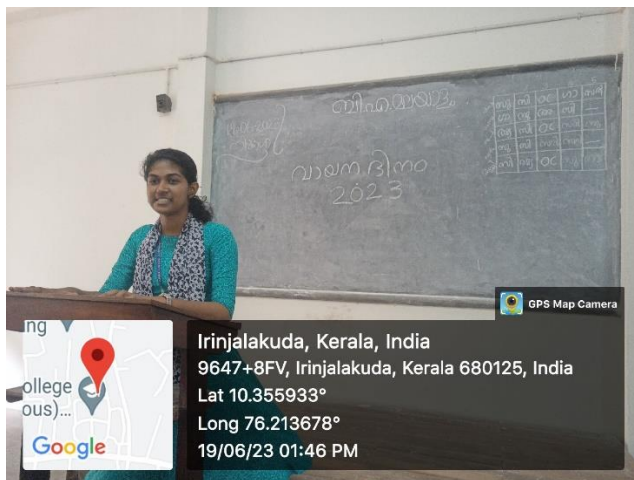
**Programme Report:**

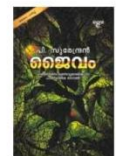

*Programme Report:*

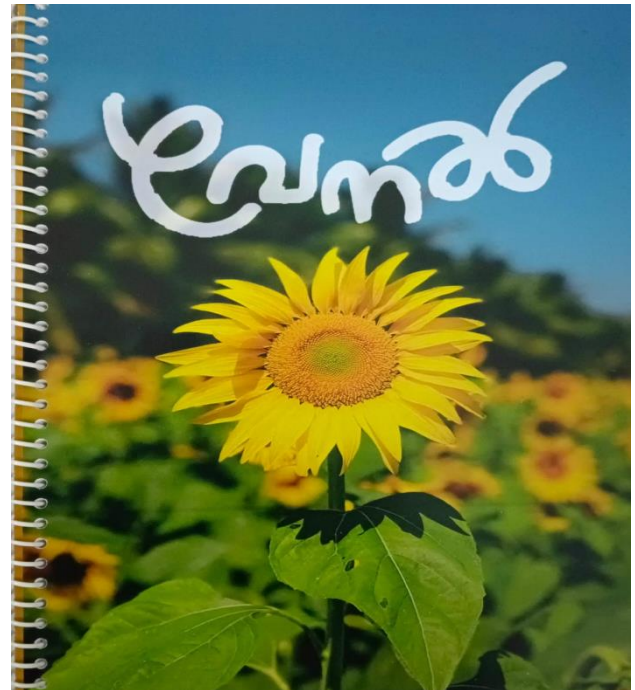
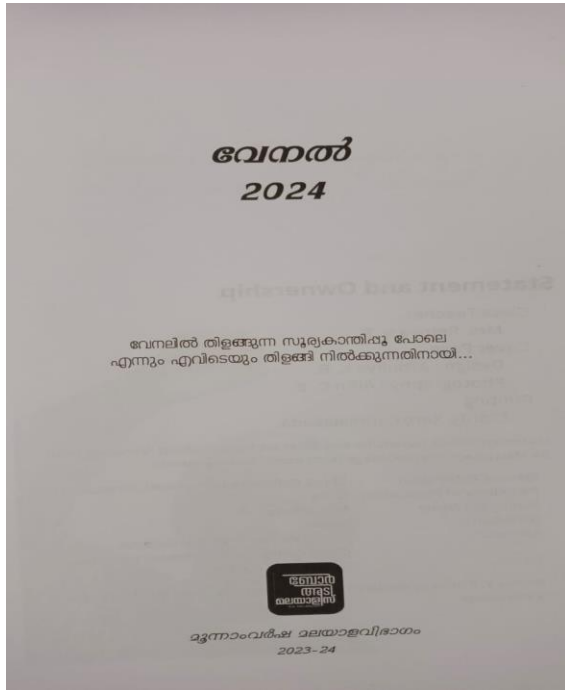
The production of class magazine has been done as part of the curriculum for the past few years. Magazines play a crucial role in developing communicative and expressive skills of students.

1. The session facilitated the dissemination of research findings, contributing to the advancement of knowledge in the field.

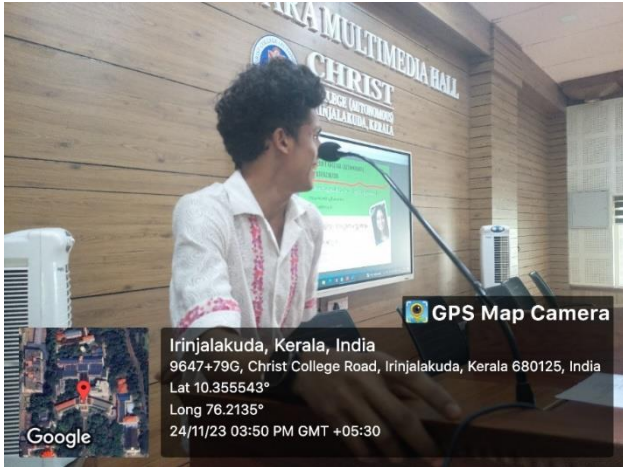


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2. Participants had the opportunity to network with peers, exchange ideas, and establish connections for future collaboration.
