But they were treated as very bad in early period. Certain rituals, beliefs, practices, culture, were separate them from the other populations. Different beliefs like to pray many forest things like many big trees, many objects which was available in their own surroundings. South Indian and North Indian tribes were different in nature. Especially, their culture was mismatching. Regional variations were also effected in their behavior pattern. Most of them were considered by others like uncivilized among other section of the society. Many laws, acts were implemented for them for uprising their position in the society. Tribes were known as the babies of forest and soil. There were many medicines were very much effective for common people also. Nowadays many people were depended on these medicines; because it's quality & it has no side effects. And they also used many medicinal leaves for making the secret medicine.

Many people were considered them as very low class people in the society. So nowadays they were very much worried about their habitats. Because now they faced challenges while living in the forest; mostly they were threatened by the human beings than animals. In the early period they were the people who worked under the land lords. This type of social system was treated them as lower people and behave very cheap towards them in early period. Now the percentage becomes less than the ancient time. There were many laws and regulations were implemented for the uplift of tribes but they don't have much knowledge about their rights. Their education is also an important issue in the society. They lose their fundamental rights. In this project I tried to mention about the life of tribes; special reference to the Malaya Pulaya and Parayas of Thamaravellachal village.

Tribal were very aggressive in nature, because they lived a peaceful& isolated life in their own comfort zone. They do not encourage any external forces to enter in their
