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# **One-Week National Faculty Development Program (FDP) on Scientific Writing and Publishing**

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## **Introduction**

The One-Week National Faculty Development Program (FDP) on Scientific Writing and Publishing was successfully organized from October 9th to October 16th, 2023. The event, hosted by Teaching Learning Centre, Christ College (Autonomous), Irinjalakuda, aimed to equip faculty members, research scholars, and academicians with the essential skills and knowledge required for high-quality scientific writing and publication in reputed journals. The program, featuring expert resource persons and interactive sessions, was meticulously designed to address various aspects of scientific research and ethical publishing.

## **Inaugural Session**

The program commenced on October 9th, 2023, with a formal inaugural session. The welcome address was delivered by Fr. Dr. Jolly Andrews CMI, Principal of Christ College, emphasizing the importance of fostering a research-oriented academic environment. Dr. M. Nasser, Director of Research, University of Calicut, inaugurated the program, sharing insights



into the significance of adhering to global standards in research writing and publication ethics. The vote of thanks for the inaugural session was delivered by Dr. Linto Alappat, Dean of Research and Development and TLC. Dr. Alappat expressed heartfelt gratitude to the distinguished guests, resource persons, and participants for their presence and support, setting a positive tone for the program's proceedings.

### **Day-Wise Summary**

#### **Day 1: October 9th, 2023 – Scientific Conduct**


The first day focused on Scientific Conduct, led by Dr. Aleena Sebastian from NIAS, Bengaluru. The sessions included discussions on research integrity, ethical considerations, and plagiarism. Dr. Sebastian underscored the importance of maintaining transparency and reliability in research outputs. The day concluded with an interactive discussion session, allowing participants to clarify doubts and share experiences.

#### **Day 2: October 10th, 2023 – Publication Ethics**

The second day featured continued sessions by Dr. Aleena Sebastian, delving into Publication Ethics. Topics such as authorship criteria, conflict of interest, and dealing with unethical practices were explored in depth. Dr. Sebastian provided practical examples and tools to help participants identify and avoid potential pitfalls in the publication process.

#### **Day 3: October 11th, 2023 – Philosophy and Ethics**

Renowned philosopher Prof. Sundar Sarukkai, founder of Barefoot Philosophers, conducted sessions on Philosophy and Ethics. He emphasized



the role of ethics in the broader context of academic research, encouraging participants to reflect on the philosophical dimensions of their work. Prof. Sarukkai's engaging teaching style fostered thought-provoking discussions among the participants.

#### **Day 4: October 12th, 2023 – Open Access Publishing**

The focus of the fourth day was on Open Access Publishing, with sessions led by Dr. N. Meenakshi Sundaram from Vivekananda College, Madurai. Participants were introduced to the advantages of open-access platforms, methods for identifying legitimate journals, and strategies for maximizing research visibility in the digital age.

#### **Day 5: October 13th, 2023 – Publication Misconduct**

Dr. Meenakshi Sundaram continued on the fifth day, addressing Publication Misconduct. Topics included the repercussions of data fabrication, falsification, and plagiarism. The sessions highlighted the role of institutional policies in combating misconduct and the responsibility of researchers to uphold the credibility of scientific literature.


#### **Day 6: October 14th, 2023 – Web Tools and Resources**

On the sixth day, Dr. Subashree Nag from Clarivate introduced participants to Web of Science and EndNote. Following this, Dr. Ramesh Kumar from GITAM University demonstrated various tools for enhancing research quality, such as citation analysis and collaborative platforms. Mrs. Gargi Rastogi, PI Lead, ORCID India, shared insights on establishing researcher profiles and the importance of unique identifiers in academic publishing.

## **Day 7: October 16th, 2023 - Practical Sessions, Assignments and valedictory session**

The final day was dedicated to practical assignments. Participants applied the knowledge gained throughout the week to draft research proposals, identify suitable journals, and develop effective publication strategies. Resource persons provided personalized feedback, ensuring the learning outcomes were effectively achieved. The valedictory session began with a welcome speech by Ms. Ann Mary Cherian, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, and Secretary, TLC. She extended her appreciation to the participants for their active engagement and enthusiasm throughout the FDP. Dr. Xavier Joseph, Vice Principal of Christ College, delivered the presidential address. He commended the efforts of the organizing committee and emphasized the importance of continuing initiatives that foster academic growth and research excellence. As part of the valedictory session, Dr. Xavier Joseph also inaugurated the Scholars Connect, a networking platform aimed at fostering collaboration and knowledge exchange among research scholars. The session concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Linto Alappat, Dean of Research and Development and TLC. He acknowledged the contributions of all those involved in the program's success, expressing hope that the participants would carry forward the learnings in their academic and professional pursuits.


