Dr Arun Balakrishnan delivered session on participating and experiencing learning method The workshop began by highlighting the limitations of


traditional, teacher-centered methods. It then introduced student-centered pedagogy, emphasizing its potential to foster deeper understanding, critical thinking, and engagement.

This methodology requires students to define the problem, research potential solutions, develop a plan, implement their ideas, and reflect on their outcomes. PBL fosters critical thinking, communication skills, collaboration, and problem-solving through a hands-on approach.

After lunch break the session three was handled by Ms. Greeni K I about Other Innovative Teaching Methods. The Flipped classroom approach, gamified learning experiences.

The session was aimed to equip educators with strategies and techniques to shift their teaching approach towards a more student-centered model and Dr. Shinto K.G., the IQAC Coordinator thanked the resource person for enlightening the minds of facilitators.
