Students' evaluations are determined through a combination of practice quizzes, project submissions, and interview sessions. A weightage of 20% is assigned to the project component. The assigned project entails the task of creating a resume using LaTeX. Only students who have successfully submitted their projects are eligible to participate in the final interview sessions.

During the interview sessions, a set of 10 questions from an interview question bank and 5 general questions are administered to each student. These interviews are graded out of a total of 150 marks. The top-performing responses to the 10 questions from the interview question bank are chosen as the final evaluation criteria.
