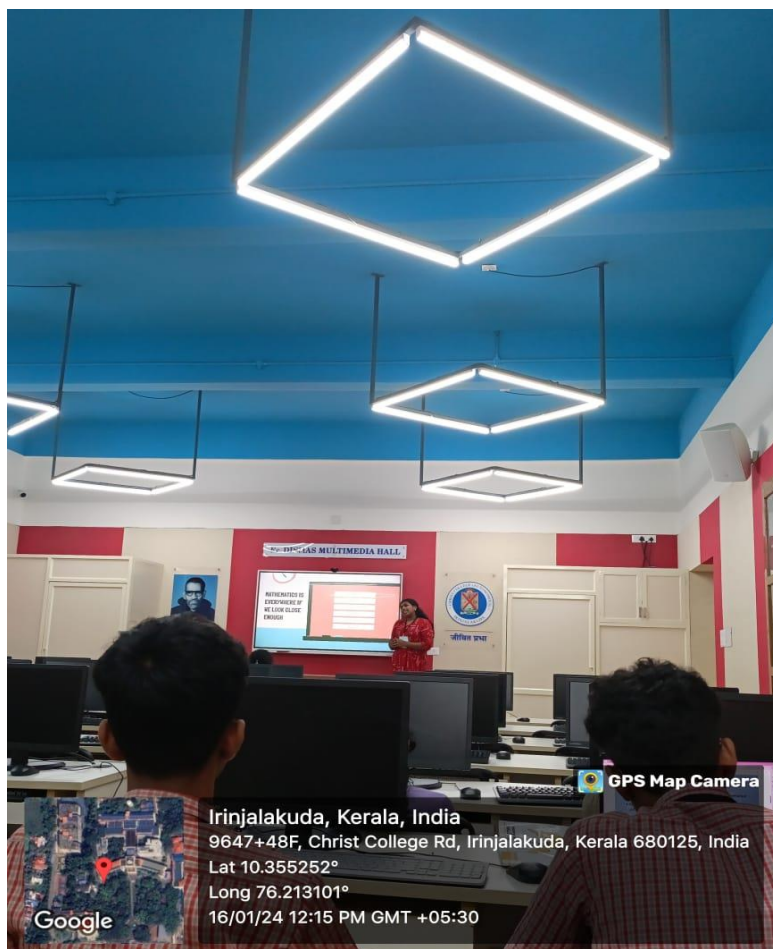
CUBE IT

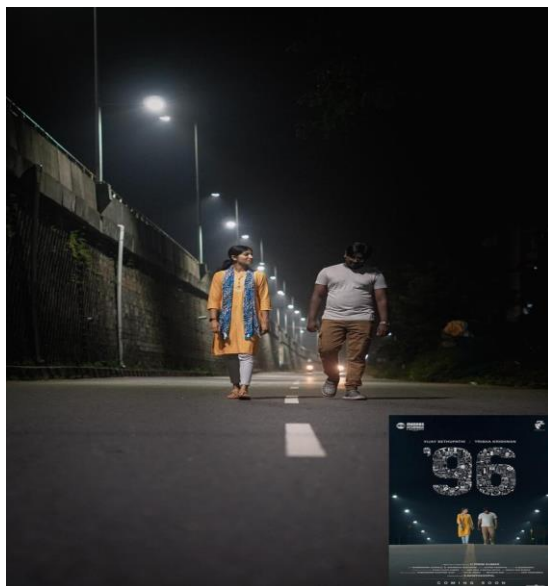
BGMI COMPETITION
