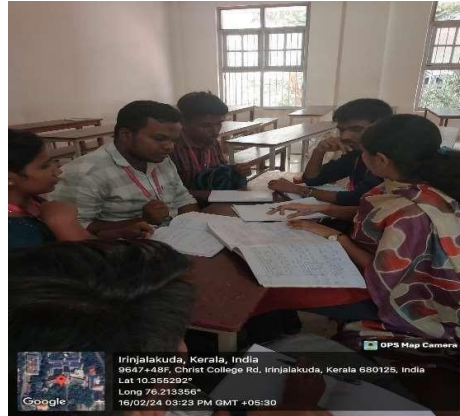
III DC Mathematics (Unaided) 2021-24 Admission


