



The programme was inaugurated and the Product was launched (Product 1.0) SOLAR DRYER

by the **All India Unnath Barath Abhiyan Coordinator Dr. Manavee Ajith Singh of the IIT- Delhi**, she is the project scientist of the UBA. She also delivered a lecture of the use and the usefulness of using this Solar Dryer in the north Indian regions where she is doing her outreach activities. After her speech she presented 2 solar dryers for 2 best Kudumbashree unit's, one to **Ms. Biji – ward Counsellor for the ward No:6 of the Irinjalakuda Municipality** and another one to **Mr. Sudhan, Panchayat President for the Padiyoor Grama Panchayat**. They will be handing it over to the best Kudumbashree Units in their respective villages. The programme was presided by Rev. Dr. Jolly Andrews CMI – Principal, Christ College, Irinjalakuda. **Dr. Jiju P. Alex, Unnath Barath Abhiyan Coordinator for the Central Kerala region** from the Kerala Agricultural University and Dr. Robinson P P, the IQAC Coordinator of Christ College felicitated the programme by their valuable words. The programme was followed by a lecture on the making & usefulness of Solar Dryers. **The lecture was delivered by Dr. V.T. Joy, Head – Department of Chemistry**. Dr. V.T.Joy has made this Solar Dryer. This solar dryer is used to dry wet Rice grains, Wheat, Mango, Lemon and various items agricultural goods before it is taken to the mill for powdering or being cooked.
