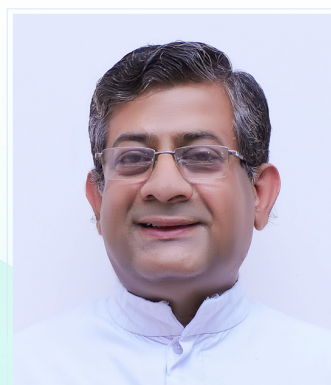
WE STAND FOR...

COURSES

RULES OF ADMISSION

Christ College is an Autonomous college and the admission to various Degree and Post Graduate Degree Courses are done by the College itself. Therefore, those who seek admission in Christ College should register online by visiting the college website www.christcollegeijk.edu.in

1. The admission to Aided courses for various Sections will be in the following ratio: General Merit - 50%; SC-15%; ST-5%; Syro Malabar Christians -10% and Management Quota-20%.
2. The admissions to the Self Financing courses will be in the following ratio : Management quota-50%; remaining 50% seats are divided into open merit - 65%, SC+ST -10%, Ezhava + Thiyya + Billava - 9%, Muslim - 8%, OBH - 5%, LC - 2%, OBX - 1%.
3. From each batch, two seats from General Merit Quota are set aside for outstanding sports persons and 5% are set aside for differently able candidates. In the absence of sufficient eligible candidates for these seats, they will be filled from General Merit List.
4. In the absence of sufficient candidates from SC/ST sections for admission, preference will be given to students from OEC category.
5. The candidates to be considered for reserved seats should attach separate certificates to prove their eligibility to be considered in that group.
6. Those who seek admissions under Management Quota should separately register online in the College Website.
7. The candidates applied for various courses will be ranked in the descending order of their index marks. There will be separate rank list for each category and admissions will be made from these lists to each category.
8. The rank list prepared for each course will be published on the College Notice Board and College Web site. It is the duty of the applicant to look up the selection list and find out the date of interview.
9. The calculation of index Marks for each course is published on the Notice board and is also available in the Web site for Verification. Weightage will be given to NCC, NSS, Finearts, the children of Jawan and Ex service men, illiteracy eradication programme
10. At the time of the interview the applicant should produce online registration printout, and the following certificates in original:
 - i) Transfer Certificate from the institution last attended
 - ii) Course and Conduct Certificate
 - iii) Mark list and pass Certificate
 - iv) Income Certificate (Only for candidates who are eligible for fee concession)
 - v) S.S.L.C. Book (for verification)
11. Immediately after the interview, the candidates, if selected, will be enrolled on payment of the fees and the submission of the Certificates.
12. Each student will be given an identity Card. He/She has to produce it for all official transactions in the College and surrender it to the office on his/ her leaving the College.
13. If any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student will be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the student will be expelled from the institution.
14. For completing the admission process in the college, the candidates should have to get the CAP ID of Calicut University.

FEE CONCESSION (AIDED COURSES)

a) Students belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe and other eligible communities, who are bonafide students of Kerala State, are eligible for fee concession and stipend. They will have to produce a certificate of Nativity and Community (only if these are not specified in their S.S.L.C. Book, for S.C. & S.T. Students) from a Revenue officer not below the rank of a Tahsildar.

b) Poor students of other Backward Communities are eligible for fee concession. They will have to produce the necessary Nativity and Income Certificate at the time of their admission.

c) Members of the forward Community students are also eligible for fee concession provided they are within the income limit.

Annual Income Limits for the Concession :

Degree and Post Graduate Rs. 1,00,000. The Income Certificate obtained from the Village Officer is a requisite for the above concession. It will have to be presented at the time of admission.

1. PRAGATHI SAMMAN (MERIT SCHOLARSHIP)

Pragathi Samman is the merit scholarship instituted by Christ College Management to motivate and help the meritorious students of the aided departments of Christ College.

2. Vidyadhanam scholarship (Fee Concession Scheme)

No worthy student should drop out from Christ College due to financial problems.

Vidyadhanam is the merit cum means Fee Concession Scheme instituted by Christ College Management to motivate and help the meritorious and financially weaker students of the self-financing departments of Christ College. The aim for the establishment of the scholarship was the vision of the Management that no worthy student should drop out from the self-financing programs due to the financial constraints. The amount for Vidyadhanam will be collected from well-wishers, Alumni and staff members of the college and those who contribute an amount of Rs 10,000 or above will be given in College Hand book as a mark of the appreciation by Management.

HOSTELS

Hostel accommodation is available for boys and girls. Establishment charges may vary from Rs.1000 to Rs. 1500 per year depending upon the nature of the hostel and accommodation provided. Mess is run on the dividing system and the monthly mess bill may vary from Rs. 3000/- to Rs. 4000/-.

UGC – Coaching Academy

With the financial assistance from UGC, Christ College runs an academy for the coaching cladded for Civil Services and CSIR/UGC examination only for those students who are weak in their course /subject. Admission is free for SC. ST students, and partially subsidized for OBC/OEC/Minority students.

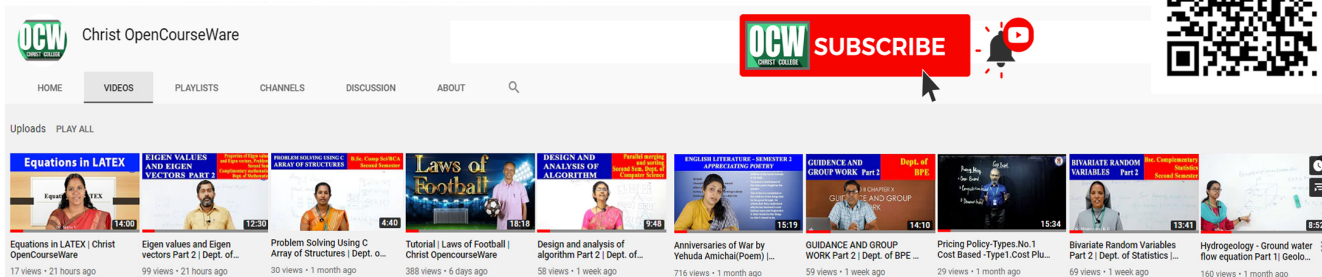

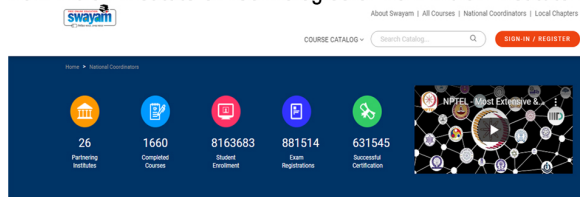

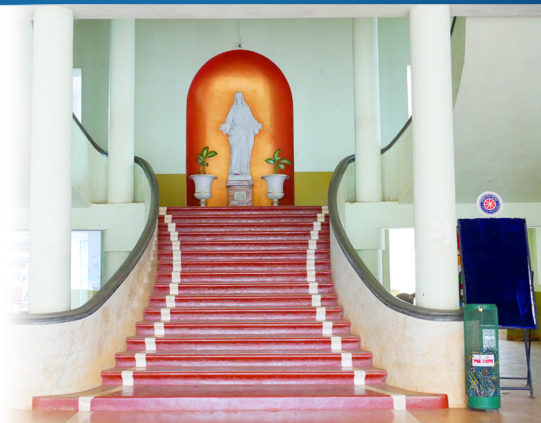
