In connection with world environment day celebration NSS units of Christ college had started a new project “Prakrithikkayi”. Under this new banner several programs had been conducted and planned. The projects were inaugurated by Christ college principal in charge Rev. Fr. Dr. Jolly Andrews CMI. On June 1st an Intercollegiate online mobile photography contest was conducted on the topic” Impacts of Lockdown on Environment”. Around 50 colleges in Kerala participated in the event. And on June 4th and 5th volunteers had planted 1111 saplings. The volunteers had planted these saplings in their home and also on the surrounding areas. Also, around 111 saplings were donated to the different areas of vainthala, kuzhur, erayamkudi and madathumpadi. The volunteers were very interested to do these activities. In the current scenario these activities were carried out in a safe manner and according to the rules. The Units also introduced Eco friendly cloth bags stitched by the volunteers. The project “Prakrithikkayi” is not meant to be a one-day program but it was decided to continue all through the year and to plant more than 10000 trees per year.

As part of this project, Christ college NSS units had planned to conduct a webinar on the topic ' Environment and biodiversity ' on 8th June and had released ' Lockdown E- magazine “BHAVASARGA” on June 10th. Prof. Tharun R, prof. Jinsy S R, prof. Jomesh Jose, prof Linnet George had lead the volunteers to achieve this glory.
