A welcome speech was delivered by Titus Varghese. The inaugural address was delivered by CSA animator Prof. Jebin K. Davis, and the felicitation was given by Sr. Rosy VO. Then Prof. Jebin K. Davis, Sr. Rosy VO, and Joepaul lit the candle in the candlelight ceremony. A vote of thanks was led by Antreena Sojan.
