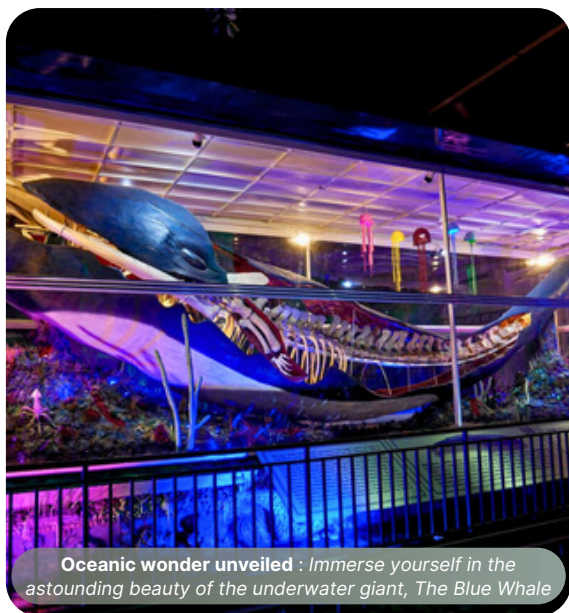

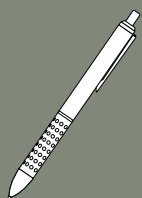

Discovery Of Species

Dr. Sudhikumar A.V.

Dr. Sudhikumar A.V discovered four new spider species from Tamil Nadu and Kerala's Western Ghats. Notably, Indopadilla kanniyakumari and three long-jawed spiders namely, Te tragnatha jaculator, Te- tragnatha lauta and Te tragnatha serra were identified, marking their first report in India.

The Shadpada Entomology Research Lab (SERL) at Christ College, Irinjalakuda, and Government College, Kodenchery, discovered two new antlion species and *Thyreus narendrani*, a cuckoo bee, from Kerala. The research team, including Doctoral Scholar Anju Sara Prakash, and supervisors Dr. Bijoy C. and Dr. Jobiraj T., made these significant findings. They honored Dr. Sanath Kumar Ghosh and the late Dr. T.C. Narendran for their expertise in entomology.

Four new species of spiders discovered from Western Ghats

A study of researchers from the Centre for Animal Taxonomy and Ecology (CATE) affiliated to the Department of Zoology, Christ College, Irinjalakuda, has discovered four new species of spiders from the Western Ghats region of Tamil Nadu and Kerala.

A new species of spider named *Indopadilla kanniyakumari* was found during the studies conducted in the grasslands of Upper Victory Estate, Kanyakumari.

This scorpion mimicking spider belongs to the group of jumping spiders, according to Sudhikumar A.V., Associate Professor and Head, Department of Zoology, Christ College, Irinjalakuda, who led the team of researchers.

"Male spiders of this new species are about 7 mm long and the body is black with yellow patches. There are scanty white hairs on the top of the head region and brown hairs around the eyes. Black coloured first pair of legs are longer than the remaining three pairs of legs, which are light brown in colour.

About 6-mm-long female individuals possess light brown abdomen and light yellow head region. Body is covered with white

low in colour. This jumping spider feeds on small insects present in the grasslands," he said.

Very long jaws

Three species of long-jawed spiders, found during the studies conducted in the Western Ghats region of Wayanad and Kasaragod, were identified as

web-building spiders, *Tetragnatha jaculator*, *Tetragnatha lauta* and *Tetragnatha serra*, possess very long jaws which are used for handling the prey, so the name *Tetragnatha* (long-jaw).

Researchers discover new cuckoo bee species in kole wetlands

A new species of cuckoo bee, *Thyreus narendrani*, has been discovered in the State. Researchers of Shadpada Entomology Research Lab (SERL), Christ College (Autonomous), Irinjalakuda, and Government College, Kodenchery are behind this discovery.

The new species is named after the late T.C. Narendran, Professor of Zoology, in honour of his expertise in entomology. The new species was collected from the kole wetland ecosystem of Sravilaka-

Thirissur and Malappuram and were declared as Ramsar sites in 2002. Doctoral scholar Anju Sara Prakash, research supervisor Bijoy C., Assistant Professor of Christ College, Irinjalaku-

menoptera. The genus *Thyreus* consists of cuckoo bees or cleptoparasitic bees. Cuckoo bees parasitise the nest of other bees by breaking and entering and laying their eggs. Unlike other female bees, cuckoo bees lack pollen-collecting structures. Once the cuckoo bee's larva hatches out in the nest of the host bee, it consumes the food stored by the host for its own growing larva.

The findings are published online in the recent issue of the international journal *Oriental Insects*. The research was conducted

Bees are known for their role as pollinators. They are responsible for the pollination of food crops as well as natural vegetation. So, conservation of bees is very important for the sur-

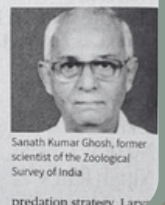
Research team discovers two new antlion species in State

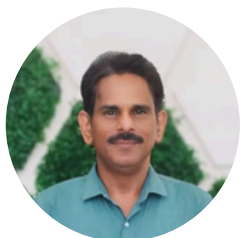

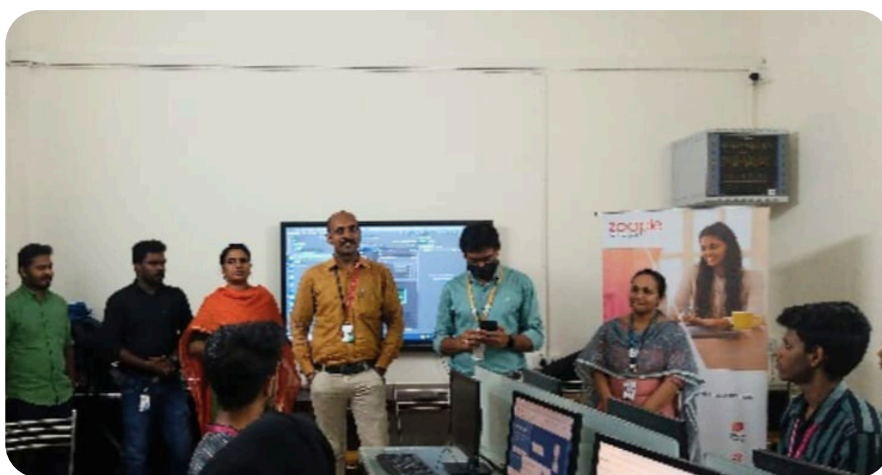

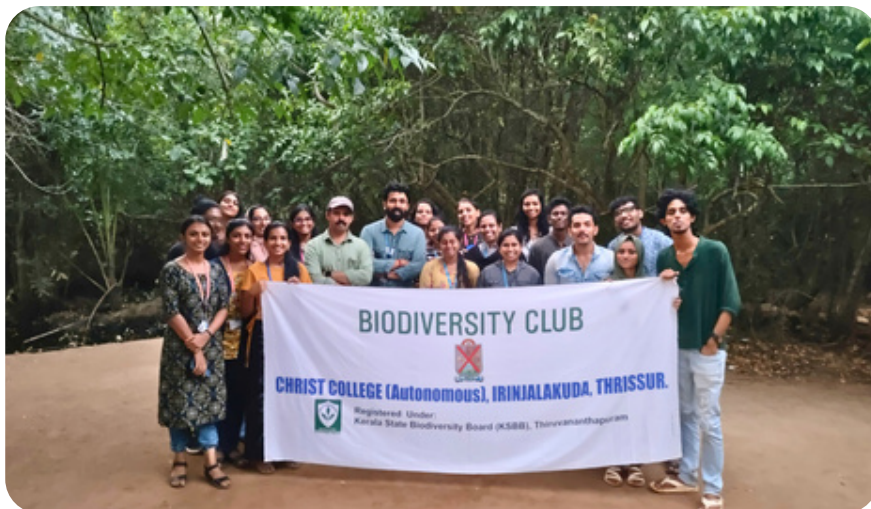
