

കേരളം ന്ന് MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING A 770241

This is a memorandum of understanding entered into effect from 20th Sep.2021 between Accountants Academy, an authorized training partner of Keltron, herein after referred as the First party represented by Jacob M V, Mechery House, Meloor

AND

Christ College Irinjalakuda, Kerala, hereix after referred as the Second party, represented by the Principal on the other part.

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Whereas the First party is engaged in the training of 'Filing the Goods & Services Tax' and the other technical courses certified by Keltron Knowledge Centre, Vellayambalam, Trivandrum.

Whereas the Second party has agreed to allow the First party to conduct GST filling course, awareness regarding Tally to the B.Com and BBA students of Christ college in the premises of Christ college campus.

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Now it is hereby agreed between the parties as follows

- 1. The First party shall conduct courses in Christ college campus under the supervision of the Second party.
- 2. The courses shall be conducted as per syllabus designed by the First party.
- Syllabus shall be designed by the First party and shall provide all course materials to the students.
- 4. The Second party shall provide the infrastructure for conducting courses i.e. Furniture, electricity, water supply and computer lab. All other equipment necessary for the conduct of the courses shall be provided by the first party including computer software and consumables.
- 5. The Second party shall be entitled to evaluate the performance and the standard of faculties provided by the First party from time to time and shall also have the right to demand correction / up gradation, monitor, if any noticed during such evaluation.
- 6. The First party shall collect the course fee from the students and remit 15% to the second party.
- 7. The First party shall be liable for payment of all sorts of taxes including GST.
- 8. The First party shall be responsible for certification of students upon successful completion of the course.
- 9. All expenses towards faculty honorarium and other incidental expenses necessary for conduct of the course shall be borne by the First party.
- 10. In case damages are done to the structure, furniture, computer lab or any other infrastructure, first party should make compensation to the damages.
- 11. Both the parties reserve its right to claim damages and cancel this MOU if the other party fails to follow the terms and conditions or guidelines in the MOU.
- 12. This MOU shall be valid for a period of two years from 1st October 2021 to 30th September 2023. The contract shall be renewed for completion of the course for the students, who enroll in the above mentioned period.

13. Any disputes between the parties may be settled by mutual negotiations between the heads of the parties. If it is not settled, the legal proceedings should be in the jurisdiction of Irinjalakuda Court.
