Since the studentswere in their final year, on merciful grounds, the Council decided thatAloshShaju-Class No. 950, Jilby Joy Mathew- Class No. 974 and Bhatty Joseph- Class No. 966, may be allowed to write their Semester exams if they had the required attendance. Condonation would not be given. The suspension of MidhunaThankachan- Class No. 980, is extended till30-09-23. As a punitive measure she for her irresponsible behaviour she is not allowed to appear for the Fifth Semester Exam.
