In 2001-2002 P G course was offered in West Asian Studies. The programme of West Asian Studies had converted to M A History in 2004. The department was elevated to the status of Research centre in History under the University of Calicut in October 2011. Prof. Jimmy A Chirayath was the first head of the department. He was succeeded by Prof. Thattil Joseph Raphael in 1992, Dr. K T Thomas in 1999, Dr. K Chandran in 2012, Ms. Lisha KK in 2015 and Dr. Sreevidhya V in 2023.

- * Students will be able to represent their newly acquired skill in the form of documentaries, travel writings, travel vlogs, food writings, heritage tour guiding etc.

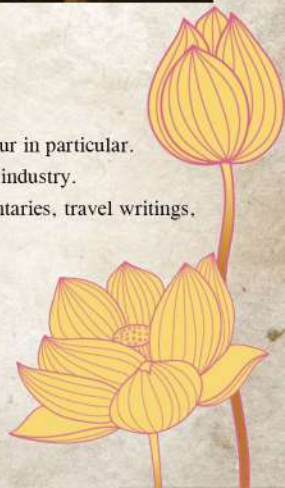

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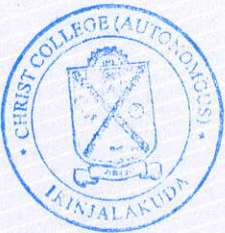
