10. Define the main objective of Jotiba Phule's reform movement. [Level:1] [CO1, CO2, CO3, CO4]

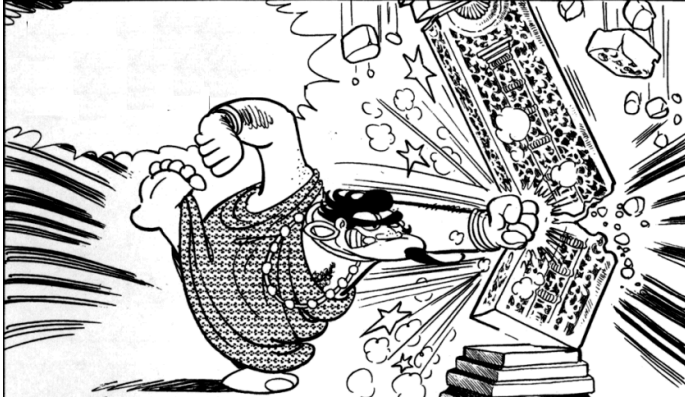
