As we enter the new academic year, we should realise that we are also entering a phase of NAAC reaccreditation. True; the past four years which was post reaccreditation period our thrust was on opening more avenues to the student community, in terms of new courses (aided or unaided; new generaton courses or traditional courses) and basic infrastructural ameneties, thanks to UGC assistance, the Government, the University, and to the wellwishers e college.

We could improve much in the number of courses, in the provided to the students. Nine new courses have been started (all in self financing sector). Besides the existing two research departments, three more PG departments have been elevated to the status of Research departments. Nearly 25000 squarefeet area has been constructed as added facilities. The newly built annexe of the ladies hostel can accomodate more of our girl students. Our quality enhancement programmes are in full swing and will fetch good results in the future.

Then only Christ College can proudly say that we stand for the moulding of our youth, as intellectually competent and psychologically integrated and committed citizens of India.




