






Chemistry Department

NSS Volunteers record audio books for the visually challenged throughout Kerala called Sraviyam. The NSS Units of Christ College organises an all Kerala Inter collegiate arts festival for NSS Volunteers whole of Kerala called as PRATHIBA, which is being conducted for 24th year consecutively. Next year we celebrate the Silver Jubilee of Prathiba competitions. This year the NSS Units celebrated the decennial celebration of the Student Police Force, which was later taken up by the Govt. as Student police cadet famously known as SPC in schools, this SPF was started by the NSS units of Christ College, Irinjalakuda. The college provides the facility of a Polyhouse for the NSS Volunteers to learn and cultivate vegetables purely Organically. Christ College NSS Units are one of the 1st colleges in Kerala to make aper pens and grow bags using flex banners and training other volunteers in different colleges. Apart from one day works the volunteers honour all the Important Days(International Yoga Day, Womens day, Senior Citizens Day, Aids day etc.) in a calendar year and conduct programmes according to its importance. In 2017 the NSS Volunteers were taken to Silent Valley National Park and given awareness on the forest and the Western Ghats. This year NSS Volunteers visited Agali village at Attapadi and interacted with the Tribal Students and trekked a Narashimuthu mountain and few anganawadis and in 2019 the volunteers visited Pakam and Neervaram villages at Wayanad and donated around 3000 books to a tribal colony at Pakam and interacted and educated the tribal folk with some action songs, street pl ays and lectures on Anti-drug campaigns and importance of education. The volunteers conduct Medical camps, clean the ponds in connection to have rain water preservation projects. During the kerala floods last onam the volunteers were involved in volunteering at different relief camps, cleaning the water and mud logged houses, renovating & building the damaged houses and painting the houses damaged by the flood.



FLOOD RELATED ACTIVITIES































Christ College, Irinjalakuda firmly stood along with the people of Kerala to face the unexpected natural calamity that strike the state very severely. The College set up a collection and distribution center on 15th August 2018 for catering basic items for different flood relief camps. The distribution center started for receiving rice, clothes, groceries and other basic items on 16th August 2018 followed by the initiation of a relief camp at the college due to the worsened situations in our neighbouring areas. The first family from Chalakudy arrived around evening followed by different families from Chalakudy, Kaattor, Arattupuzha, Mala, Muriyadu, and Padiyoor amounting to approximately 1100 people. Thavanish volunteers, NSS volunteers, union members, staff, students staying at the college hostels, regular students, social workers, common people and medical organizations contributed tremendously in making this an efficient and useful collection and distribution center for flood relief camps.


Student and staffvolunteers had taken part in cleaning the Mala Sub Treasury which was immensely affected. The volunteers actively participated in the cleaning activities with all necessary items like bleaching powder, pine oil, Dettol, brushes from college distribution center.

Thavanish distributed basic amenities like groceries, clothes, sanitary napkins and other crockeries to the inmates of the relief camp in LizzyConvent, MoorkanadHigher Secondary School, Little Flower Convent School and Government Boys High School, IrinjalakudaAnd distributed cleaning kits, rice sacks and clothes to AbhayaBhavan, an old age home, PratheekshaBhavan, a special school and StJoseph Church, Vallivattom.

Psychology department students actively participated in flood relief activities of the college and provided councelling and other help for flood victims HDPSS Padiyoor, St. Joseph HSS Pavaraty, St. Aloysius HSS Elthuruth, people at Nenmanikkara, Thrissur and for children at Cheruthoni, Idukki.

Christ College also conducted a socio economic survey in collaboration with EKN Study Center for analysing the damages and losses caused to the people and their houses at Padiyoor. In connection with the Flood mapping survey, an initiative of the government for analysing the number of houses and people affected due to the flood in order to help them with necessary financial and other aids, our volunteers visited the houses of Padiyoor, PoomangalamandMuriyadu to collect information using 'REBUILD KERALA' app. Students of Computer science department involved helping the Govt. officials for automating the details of flood affected people and digitalizing the flood related details of PadiyoorPanchayat.




